**Favorite Things** **Saturday** **1:30-3:30**

This quilt has a sweet fresh feel and can easily be pulled together from a mix of your favorite colors. The curves add a whimsical element that double as branches. Suitable for an experienced beginner (good rotary-cutting skills and able to maintain a consistent quarter inch seam).

**Fractured Images** **Thursday OR Sunday** **12:30-5:30**

Want to learn how to create this interesting effect that makes your fabric appear to vibrate? If you like surprises, this is a class for you. We'll make a wall hanging that will amaze all of us. Plan on getting most of the top put together during our class time. Just be forewarned: you won't be able to stop with just one.

**French Braid** **Wednesday** **1:00-3:00**

This pattern is a great way to use your 2 1/2 " strips. Pick a theme fabric and then choose fabrics to coordinate, or make it scrappy for a totally different effect.

**Hunter's Star with a Modern Twist** **Thursday** **1:00-4:00**

The Hunter's Star block makes a wonderful two color quilt. Find a distinctive fabric to insert a frame here and there amongst the Hunter's Star blocks, and from this fabric select your two colors for the star block. A light and a dark would be best so there is a high contrast.

**Jubilee** **Friday** **1:00-4:00**  
**Nancy Tubbs** **February 24, March 2** **\$30**

Do you have a couple of jelly rolls or Bali pops? Or just a lot of 2 1/2 " scrap strips that you don't know what to do with? Then this is the quilt for you! It's easy, it's fun, and the results are great, no matter what fabrics you use! You may not be able to make just one. The class sample takes the equivalent of approximately 72 2 1/2 " x width of fabric strips. This is a great way to dig into your stash and use some of that beautiful fabric you have.

**LeMoyne Star** **Wednesday** **1:00-4:00**

**Pickle Dish** **Monday** **1:00-4:00**

It is always fun to make an old favorite. Mary will teach you to use freezer paper to paper piece the arcs for this block which will make them easy, fun, and quick to do.

**Piping Hot Curves** **Friday** **10:30-4:30**

Piping adds easy excitement to projects, and the book 'Piping Hot Curves' makes it lots of fun, too! Choose one of the designs in the book and get ready to get piping hot.

- Quilted Postcards** **Saturday** **1:00-4:00**  
**Bonnie Sabel** **March 17** **\$15**  
 Make a quilted postcard of your choice with the author of “Positively Postcards”! Postcards are fun to make and offer a great opportunity to “test drive” some creativity and art techniques that one might be reluctant to try on a larger scale. Discover the five basic techniques for designing quilted postcards, and learn Bonnie’s construction techniques that are easily adapted to Journal Quilts or other small quilts. The edges of the postcard or small quilt will have the support of a half inch of stiffener invisibly fused to two layers of batting, but the actual edges of the quilt will have none of the batting to deal with. (\$8.00 - \$12.00 kit fee for front, innards, and back of postcard of your choice.)
- Stained Glass** **Friday** **10:30-4:30**

 This is a great paper piecing project and can be made larger with additional blocks; the book has 36 different blocks to choose from. You can make a small wall hanging, pillow shams, or a larger project as you desire.
- Storm at Sea** **Friday** **10:30-4:30**  
**Victoria Jones** **March 16** **\$35**  
 You’ll learn the perfectionists’ twist to classic piecing as your color choices create an intriguing interplay of curvy layers and perfectly pointed stars. My sample is a 40” square based on the Red Sky At Morning project in the book and can hang on the wall, be used as a table topper, or is spectacular enough to become the center of a larger quilt.
- Tuesday’s Choice** **Tuesday** **1:00-4:00**  
**Nancy Tubbs** **February 7, 14, 21** **\$45**  
 This is such a happy quilt! The pattern was designed to showcase Kaffe Fassett fabrics, but would work equally as well in batiks, soft pastels, black and whites. Choose whatever fabrics make you feel good. The quilt is not as complicated as it looks. Intermediate.
- Tutti Frutti** **Friday** **10:30-4:30**  
**Victoria Jones** **February 10** **\$35**  
 This is a great paper piecing project; it will finish in an octagon shape and would make an unusual wall hanging or table topper. The finished size is 28” x 28”. The techniques learned in this project will include paper piecing, and while you will not finish the project during the class we will discuss how you will be able to finish it yourself later.
- Wild and Crazy Cake Stands** **Monday** **1:00-4:00**  
**Christie Curtz** **February 20, 27** **\$40**  
 Enjoy playing with color and texture in your fabric selections to create a one of a kind quilt. Be free and crazy with your choice of fabrics to rock the cake stand pattern on its ear!
- Winding Ways** **Saturday** **10:30-4:30**  
**Christie Curtz** **February 18** **\$40**  
 Enjoy learning to use templates and a slight curved piecing design of Winding Ways. It really is fun to do, so come enjoy the class. Select a border fabric and then build your colors, textures, and designs around it. The selection of light and dark fabrics used in this quilt create an alternate circular design.
